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5 Student Health/Physical Screenings/Examinations

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7 The Board may arrange each year for health services to be provided to all students. Such services
8 may include but not be limited to:

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10 1. Development of procedures at each building for isolation and temporary care of students who
11 become ill during the school day;
12 2. Vision and hearing screening;
13 3. Scoliosis screening;
14 4. Immunization as provided by the Department of Public Health and Human Services.
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16 Parents/guardians will receive written notice of any screening result which indicates a condition that
17 might interfere or tend to interfere with a student's progress.
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19 Students who wish to participate in certain extracurricular activities will be required to submit to a
20 physical examination to verify their ability to participate in the activity. Students participating in
21 activities governed by the Montana High School Association will be required to follow the rules of
22 that organization, as well as other applicable District policies, rules, and regulations.
